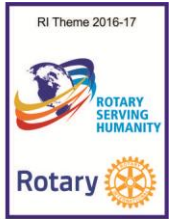

SCHEME FOR GRANT OF AWARD FOR EXEMPLARY COURAGE INSTITUTED BY ROTARY CLUB OF PANAJI MID-TOWN

1. Introduction:

- a. This scheme may be known as the Scheme for grant of an 'Award for Exemplary Courage in Saving Lives or Defending Social Rights of Others.'
- b. It shall be called the Rotary Club of Panaji Mid-Town Award for Exemplary Courage 'In Saving Lives or Defending Social Rights of Others.'

2. Selection of Awardee:

- a. Any of the member Rotary club of Goa may nominate a **Person or Institute** for the award in respect of the Previous Rotary Year (July – June), in recognition of a demonstrated instance of exemplary courage in saving lives of others, or in defending the Social Rights of others. Such acts should be of extraordinary nature, beyond the normal response of a spectator, and should be such as can be termed exemplary.
- b. The incident in respect of which the Award is recommended shall be vouched for by **at least two reputed persons/individuals** from the locality where it occurred and shall describe the role played by the nominee/ individual/institutions.
- c. All nominations shall be received by 15th November 2016 and all the nominations so received shall be scrutinised by an Award Committee, consisting of **President, Secretary, Community Service Director and Two reputed citizens from outside the club. The District Governor shall act as a Sixth member and cast his vote, in the event of tie, and otherwise approve the selection made by the Committee.** In the rare case where two equally deserving cases are recommended by the Committee, including the President of the club, the award amount shall be divided equally among the nominees, but the citation and Memento shall be presented to both. The decision of the Award Committee will be final and cannot be challenged by nominees or others.
- d. The amount shall be conferred in the following category:-
 1. **Exemplary Courage in Saving Life**, the winners shall be awarded with cash amount of Rs. 10,000/- and citation letter and shawl.
 2. **Exemplary Courage in defending Social Rights of others**; the winners shall be awarded cash amount of Rs. 10,000/- and citation and shawl.
